


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS HELIOS 2000








Technical data

The blower heater is delivered with an open grill in front for warm air, as standard. The heat coil with copper pipes & aluminium disks was designed to give the best heat transfer from water to air. 16 bars is the maximum pressure in the water circuit. The fan is composed of a two speed motor with an axial fan. Slide type bearings are used. The inlet air is taken through a grating on the backside of the unit.



Function


The heater operates with a switch or a cabin thermostat. See separate electrical wiring diagram.




Electrical connection

The unit is fitted with three connection cables: red, orange and black.

NOTE: FOR FULL SAFETY USE FUSE 5 A.









Water connection


Blower heater has to be connected to the engine cooling water only.

Reinforced rubber hoses of approved type (diameter 16 mm) must be used.


For a best capacity and water circulation, the blower heater must be installed lower than the engine expansion level.




